Trial holes on Tavern Canal Bridge

Staffordshire County Council will shortly be carrying out trial holes on Tavern Canal Bridge to determine the internal structure and thickness of the bridge structure.

How long will the works take?

The work will take 2 days to complete.

Why are the works taking place?

The internal structure and thickness of the bridge is unknown so an accurate assessment of its strength and load carry capacity cannot currently be determined.

When are the works taking place?

The investigation works will start on **Monday 30th July 2018.**

What effect could the works have on me?

As a pedestrian or cyclist the effects of the work will be minimal as you will still be able to cross the bridge, however all vehicular traffic will be diverted via A5. A diversion plan is attached.

Will I be able to access my home/business?

Access to properties and business either side of the works will be maintained throughout the works, though this may not be from the usual approach direction.
