- **Local Plan Review - consultation underway**

The Council is now consulting on the second stage of its Local Plan, which is focused on broad locations for housing growth and the infrastructure required to deliver the growth. This consultation is not site specific but looks at seven different options to deliver housing to meet South Staffordshire own housing needs and a contribution towards unmet housing need in the wider region. - **Two year milestone for South Staffordshire Community Lottery**

Thursday 24 October 2019 marked the second anniversary of the South Staffordshire Community Lottery when lottery tickets first began to be sold online. The Community Lottery was set up to help local good causes and community groups raise additional funding to support the work they do within our communities and over the last two years it has raised £47,898 for local good causes through the sale of 79,187 tickets.
