- **#GE2019 - Your Vote Matters**

As we know there is a General Election on Thursday 12 December 2019 and the deadline for voters to register is Tuesday 26 November 2019, with postal vote applications also required by Tuesday 26 November 2019 and proxy vote applications by Wednesday 4 December 2019.

Poll and postal poll cards are now beginning to be sent out so if you've registered to vote, you should receive your poll card in the next few days.

To vote in a general election your name must be on the electoral register. You can register to vote online at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote and it usually takes about five minutes. You will need to confirm your name, address, date of birth and national insurance number. Remember, you only need to register once - not for every election - but if you're not sure if you've already registered, please contact the local electoral registration office at South Staffordshire Council (tel: 01902 696121 or email: elections@sstaffs.gov.uk).

You're eligible to register to vote in elections if you are:

- Aged 16 or over (however, you can only vote when you become 18).
- A UK citizen (or an Irish, EU or Commonwealth citizen with a permanent UK address).

There are three different ways that you can vote:

- In person at a polling station.
- By post.
- By proxy (someone voting on your behalf).

- **Remembrance Day Service and two minute silence**

On Monday, a Service of Remembrance was held at the Council Offices in Codsall, officiated by the Chairman's Chaplain, the Reverend Morris Price. The service was attended by the Deputy Lieutenant of Staffordshire, Colonel Christopher Comport, Parish Chairmen, District Councillors, Council staff and representatives from the Royal British Legion, Codsall Middle School and Codsall High School. - **Community safety update - #OpLightning**

On Wednesday, Operation Lightning struck again when the South Staffordshire neighbourhood policing team carried out a road safety and traffic operation in Locality 5 of the district between 8am and 1pm. Locality 5 includes Wombourne, Swindon, Trysull and Himley and officers deploying a mixture of marked and unmarked police vehicles patrolled outside schools and conducted speed checks and checked over 100 vehicles, making sure they were all road worthy and legal. As a result, officers seized three vehicles and four people were reported to court for not having insurance. One person was reported for not having an MOT and four motorists were warned for minor traffic offences.

- **Local Plan Consultation and Interactive Local Plan map**

Consultation continues on the second stage of the Council's Local Plan, which is focused on broad locations for housing growth and the infrastructure required to deliver the growth. This consultation is not site specific but looks at seven different options to deliver housing to meet South Staffordshire own housing needs and a contribution towards unmet housing need in the wider region.
