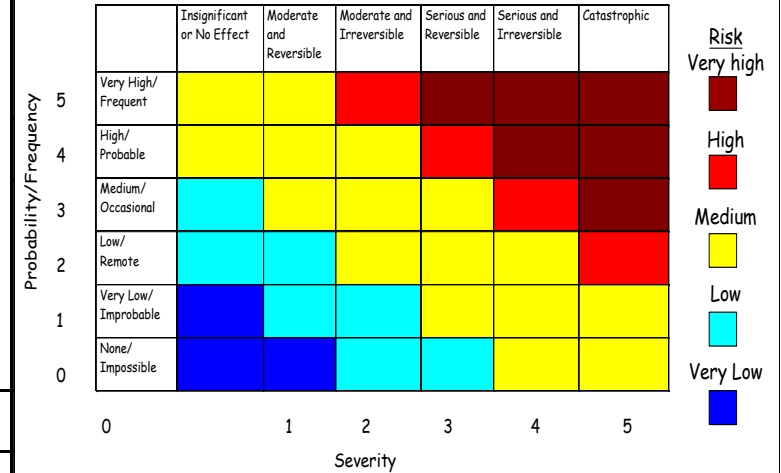

Hazard	Factors of Harm		Risk Rating		Control Measures
	Likelihood	Severity	Score	Rating	
Manual Handling	1	1	2	L	Use a litter picker to avoid un-necessary bending Use appropriate manual handling techniques - bent legs and straight back - take regular breaks to avoid fatigue Only collect litter that can be put into bags - do not move heavy or bulky items
Falls on level	1	1	2	L	Wear appropriate footwear that offers support with good grip. Assess terrain and conditions underfoot prior to commencement and defer activities if hazardous.
Cuts from sharp objects	2	1	3	L	Assess items for hazards before removing - e.g. sharp edges, unknown substances. Refer any concerns to Parish Clerk Use appropriate equipment to remove sharp objects such as broken glass etc - use a litter picker or dust pan & brush Wear protective gloves
Lone worker	1	2	3	L	advise family/friend of expected return time, always follow the council policy
Adverse Weather	3	4	7	H	To be aware of adverse weather and only conduct role if it is safe to do so. Follow MET office warnings
Vehicle turning	1	2	2	L	Consider vehicle users at all times
